Catholic Campus Ministry in The Diocese of Dodge City

Two years ago several students from Seward Community College asked St. Anthony's Church in Liberal to form a club for Catholic college students. They call themselves St. Anthony's SAINTS. The initiative taken by these students is an encouraging sign for our diocese.

We recognize that in the Diocese of Dodge City there are five Community Colleges. The Diocese extends an invitation to all college students in the diocese to participate in a retreat during Lent. It is an opportunity for students to explore their faith and to share it with one another.

The retreat will be hosted by St. Anthony's SAINTS and the Redemptorists. We especially wish to invite students from Dodge City, Garden City Barton, Pratt and Seward Community Colleges. We also welcome students from other colleges in the area.

Objectives of the Retreat

1. That students take time out of their busy schedules to slow down and consider what is important in their lives.
2. For students to reflect on Jesus in their lives.
3. For students to share their own experience of faith and morality with other students.

4. For students to have a safe environment to explore doubts and concerns.
5. For students to experience liturgy, prayer and discernment together.

Theme for the retreat: Discipleship

Jesus asked his disciple, "Who do you say that I am?" The disciples followed Jesus, listening to him, watching him, praying with him and relaxing with him. This was their introduction to discipleship.

In Baptism all are called to be disciples. Our retreat is a time to consider what that discipleship means to each individual and as a community of believers.

Where is Camp Lakeside

Camp Lakeside is located in western Kansas on Highway 83 between Scott City and Oakley, adjacent to Lake Scott State Park. It is a beautiful location with an opportunity to enjoy nature.

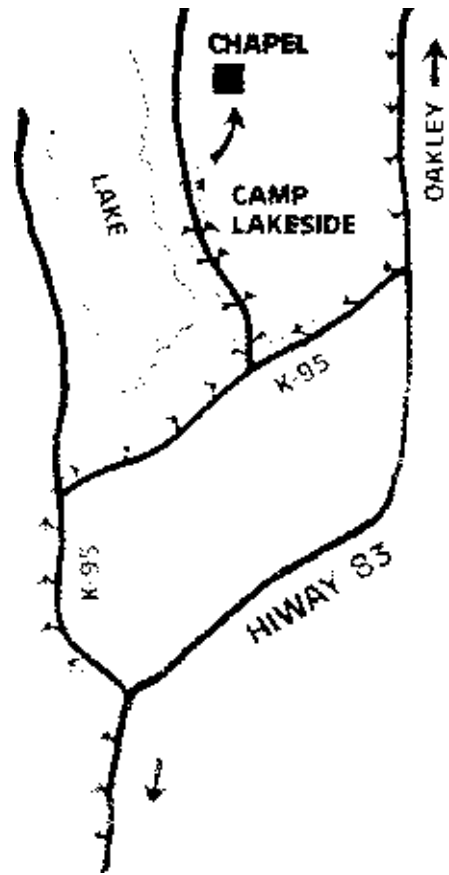
What to Bring
