

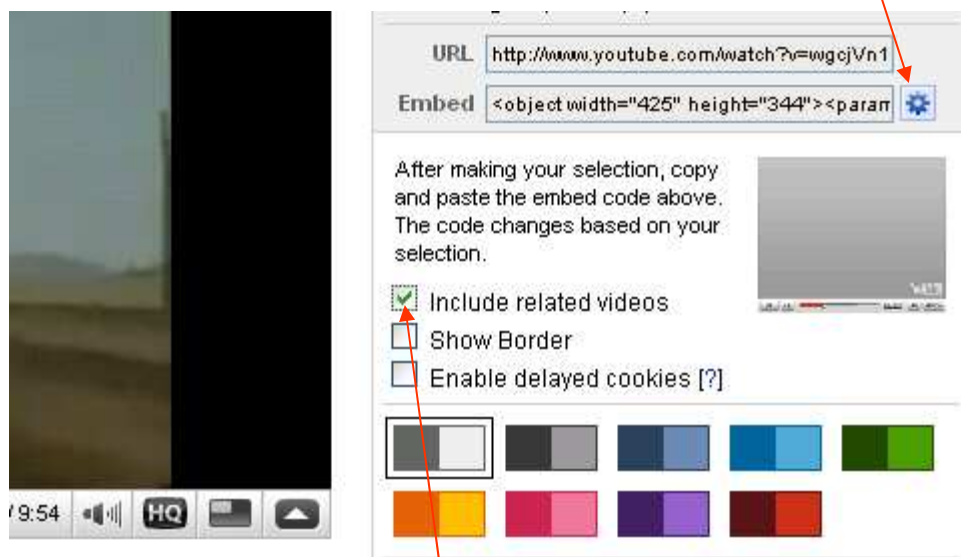
How to put a video in your article

In this How to Guide, you will learn how to “embed” a video into an article. This is useful if you see something on YouTube, PhotoBucket, Discovery Channel or some other video hosting site. Or you can upload your own video to a host site and embed your own video.

If you are having problems writing an article, refer to *Writing an Article* help guide.

#1 Locate the video you would like to share. In this example I want to share *A Day on the Wheat Harvest* I found on YouTube.

- Click the gear first, more options will appear and they are important!

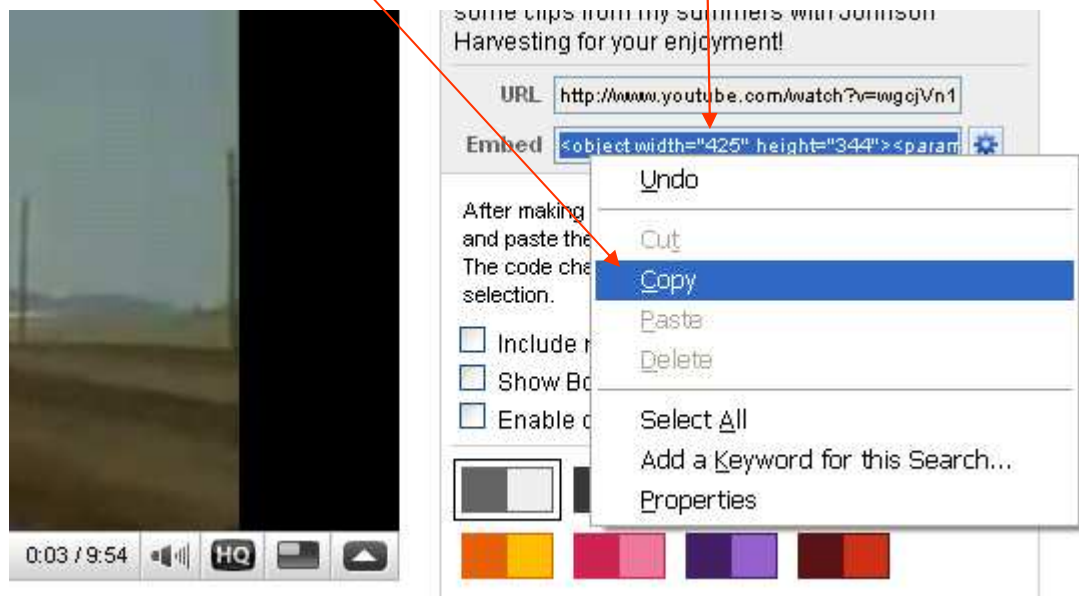


- **Unselect *Include related videos*.**

You may not want some of the related videos to appear as they may not have appropriate content. It is automatically selected by YouTube, **turn it off**. Other video hosting sites may or may not have a similar feature.

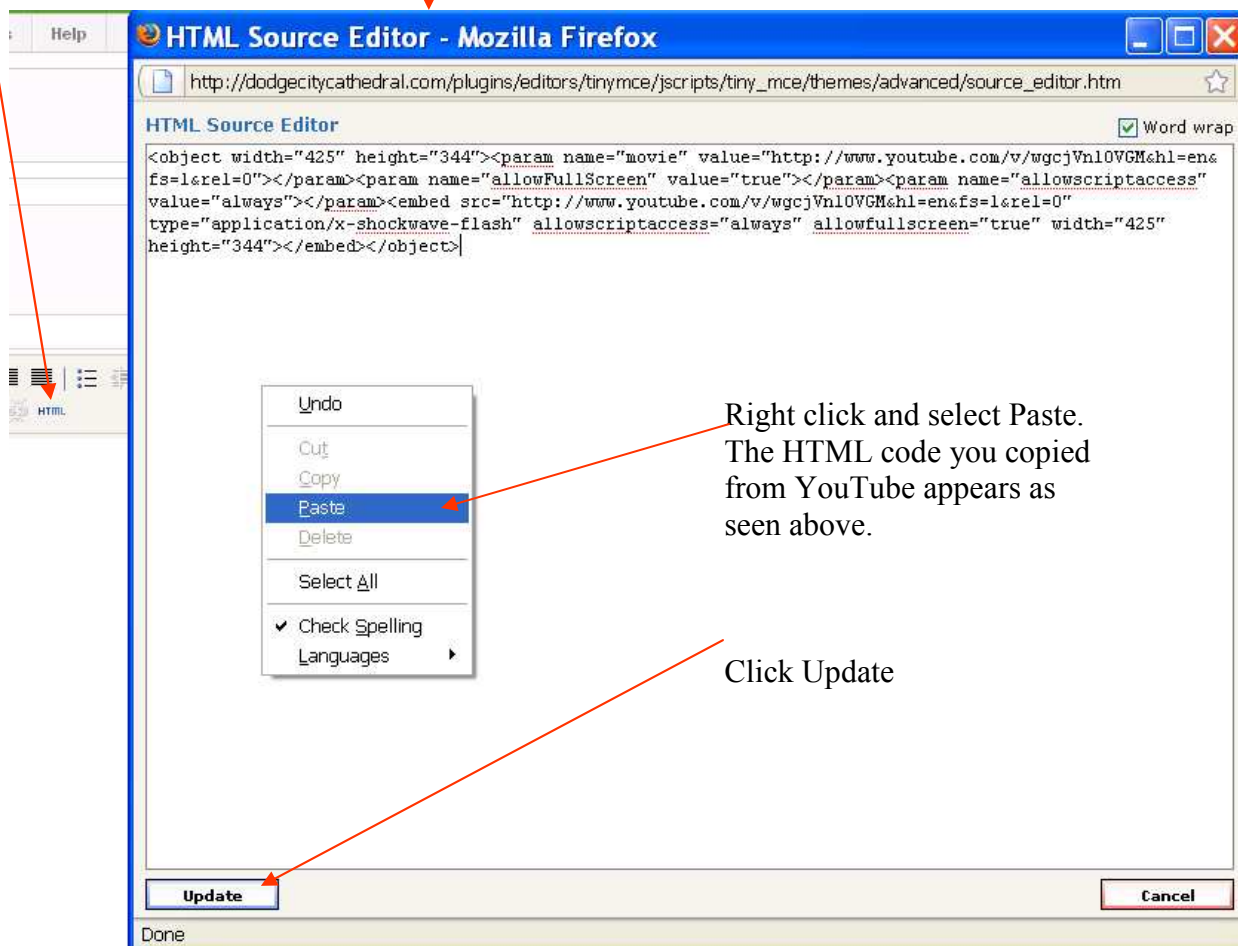
Once you have unselected, Include Other Videos, you are ready to copy and paste.

- Click inside *Embed*. The contents will highlight in Blue.
- Right click copy



Now go to Joomla and create your article. In the article menu options click the button HTML

This window pops up

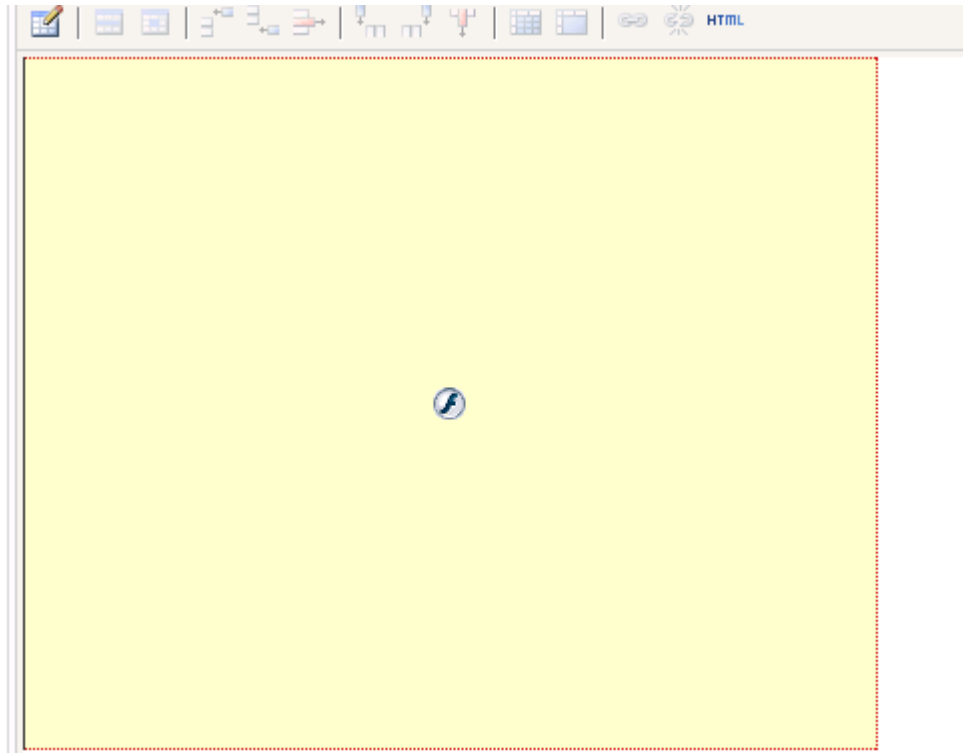


Right click and select Paste. The HTML code you copied from YouTube appears as seen above.

Click Update

Once Update has been clicked, your video will appear as shown below. You cannot play it in the “backyard”. You can only play it from your website.

This process works for any website that allows you to copy the EMBED HTML code.



If your article is complete, Save your work and you are finished.



To the right is how the video will appear on the web site (Front yard).
