Live with a local family during Days in the Diocese on the Mediterranean sharing your faith and discover a different culture.

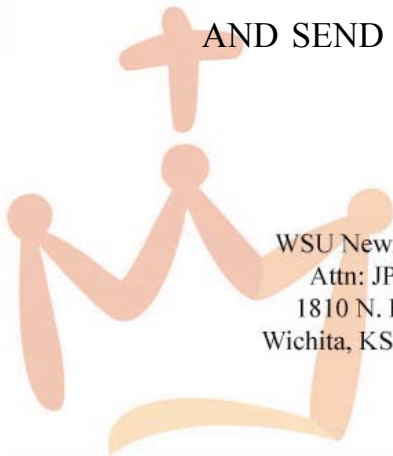
