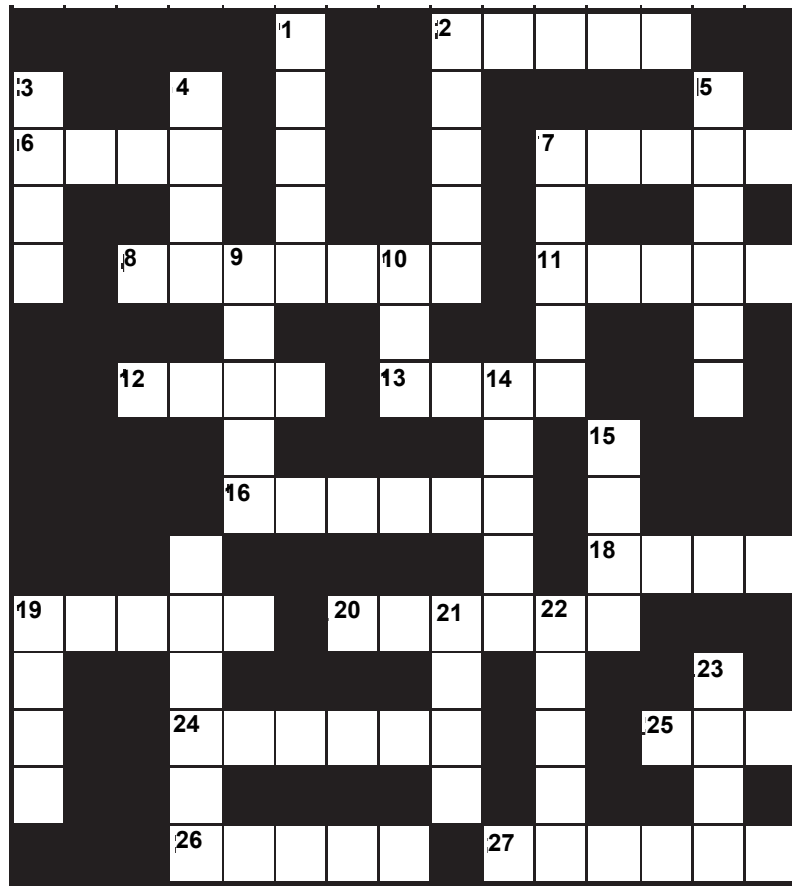


GABRIEL'S CROSSWORD

This saint was born in the third century (between 250 and 300 AD) in the village of Patara, which at the time was considered Greek, but is now the southern coast of Turkey.

His wealthy parents raised him to be a devout Christian, but died during an epidemic when this saint was still young.

With his faith firmly intact, this young man took to heart the words of Jesus to “sell what you own and give the money to the poor.” He used his entire inheritance to help the sick and needy and the suffering.

While still a relatively young man, he was made Bishop of Myra (a city on the southern Mediterranean sea coast of what is now Turkey). He became known for his generosity to those in need, his love for children, and his concern for sailors and ships.

Like other Christians, he was later imprisoned for his faith, but eventually released. He died on Dec. 6, 343 AD.

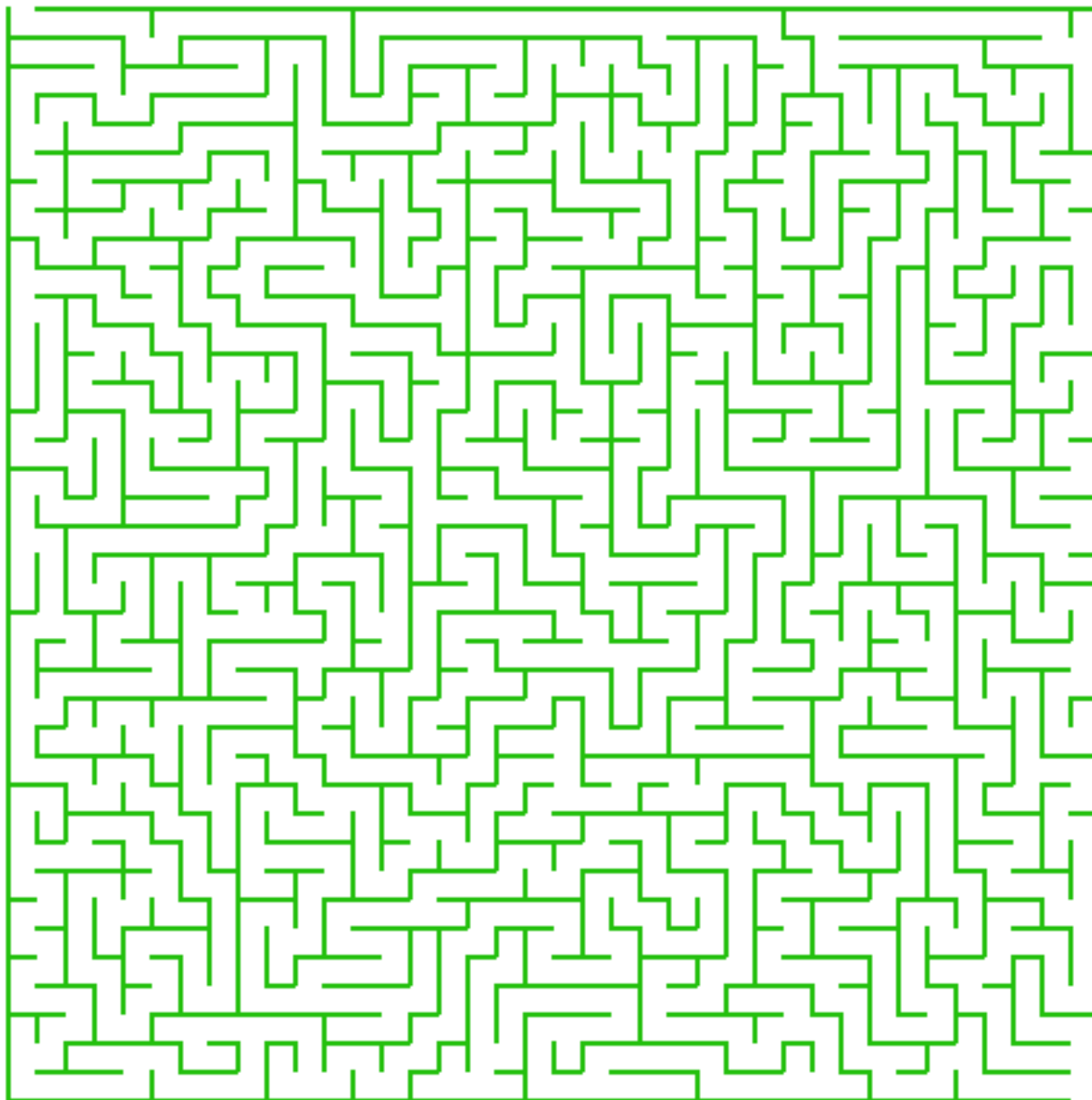
