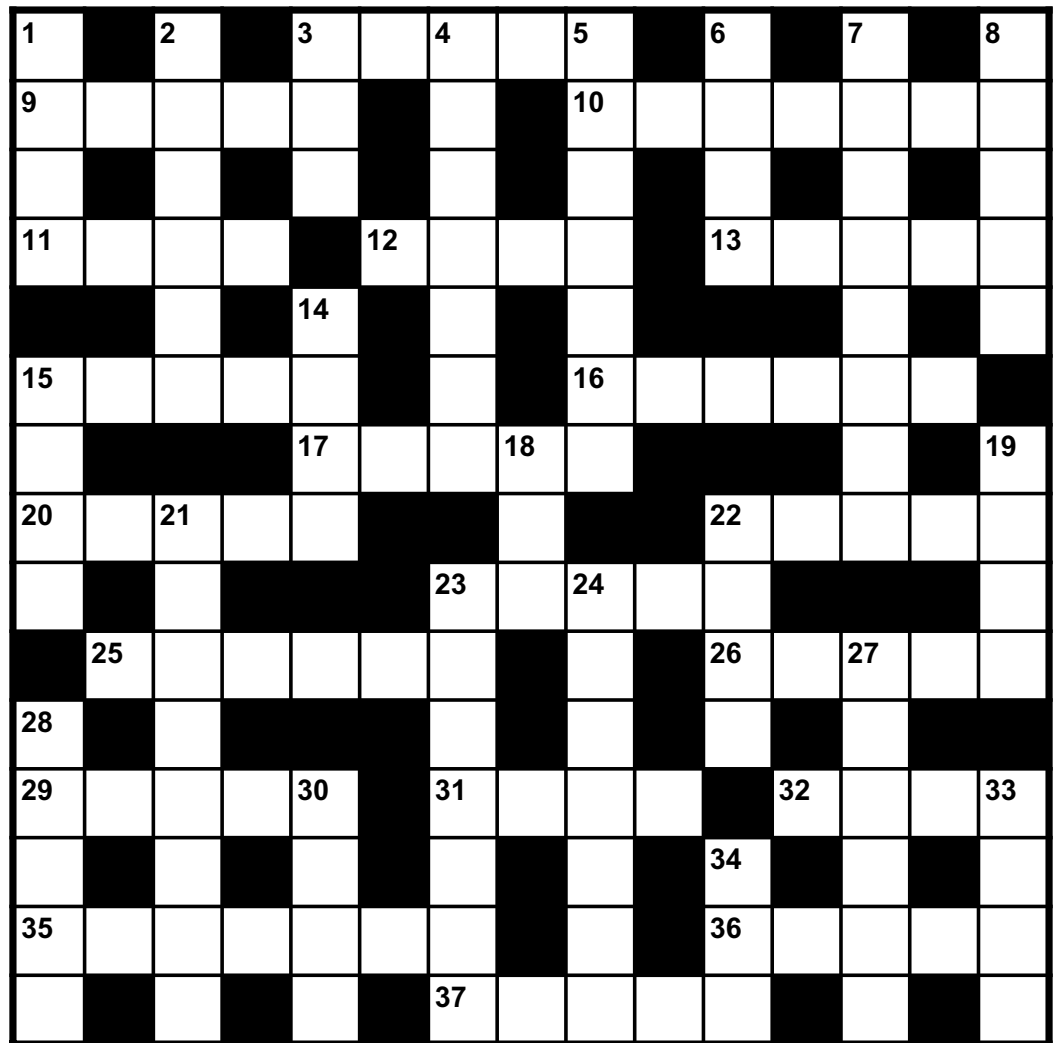

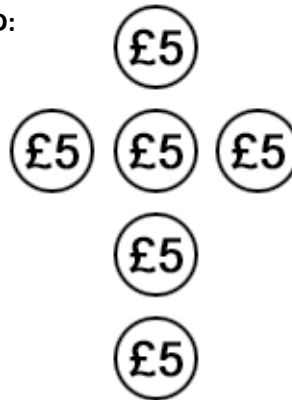
TEASER THE FIRST:

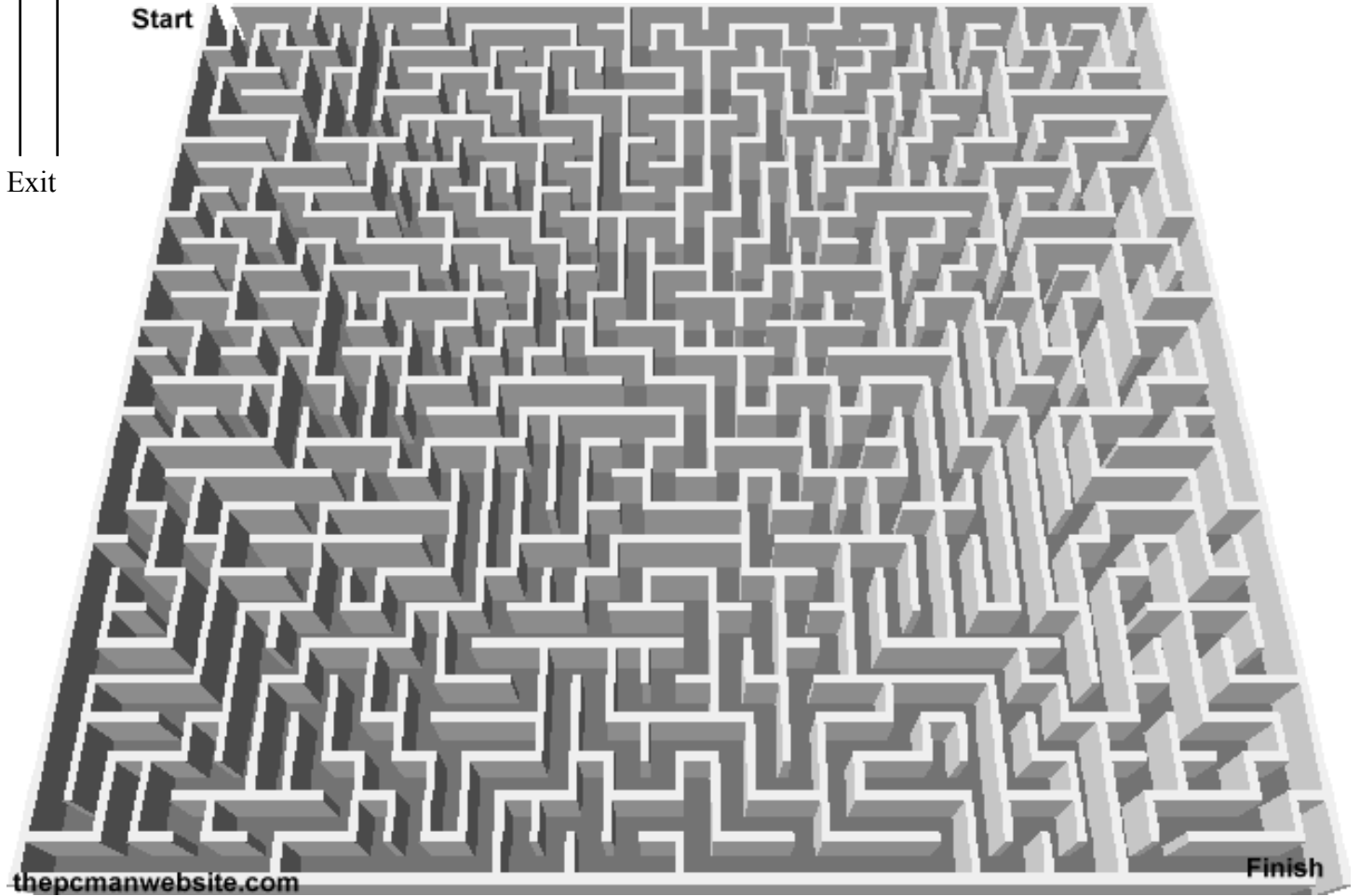

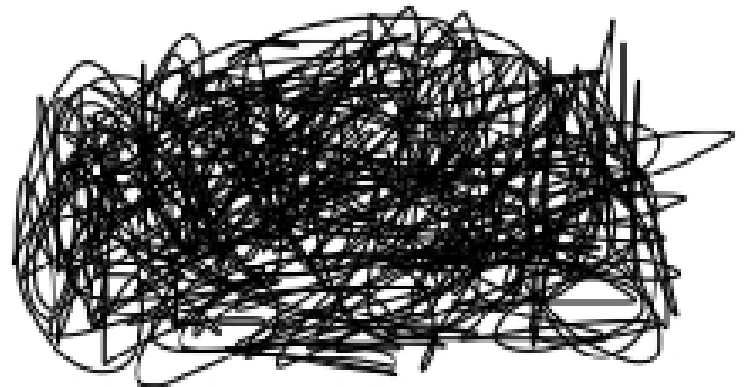
