- 4)** to damage or destroy (4 letters) & (delete 3rd letter) to enter into an election contest

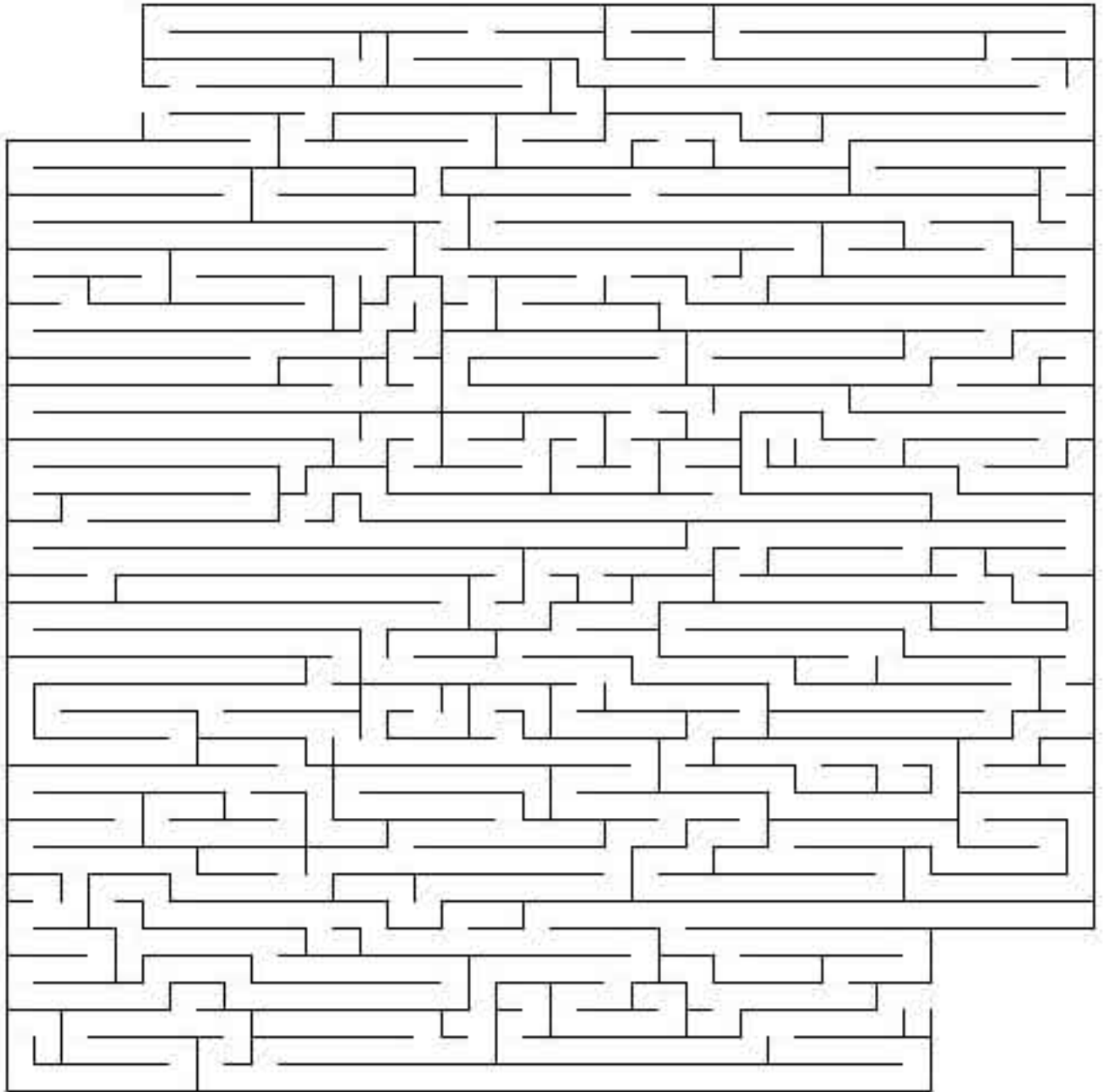

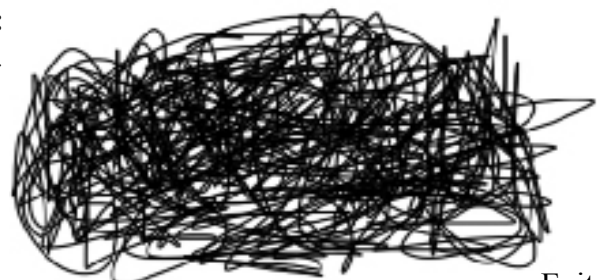
