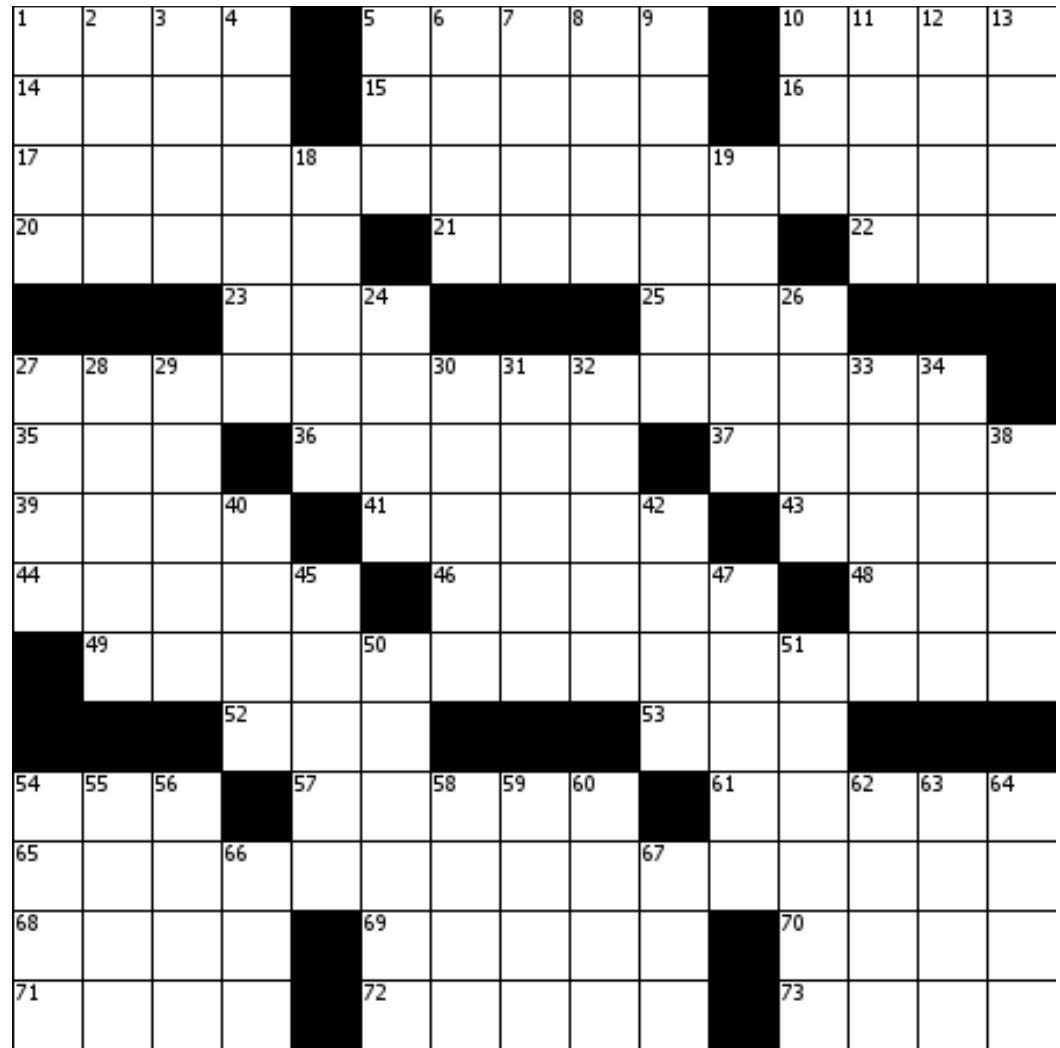

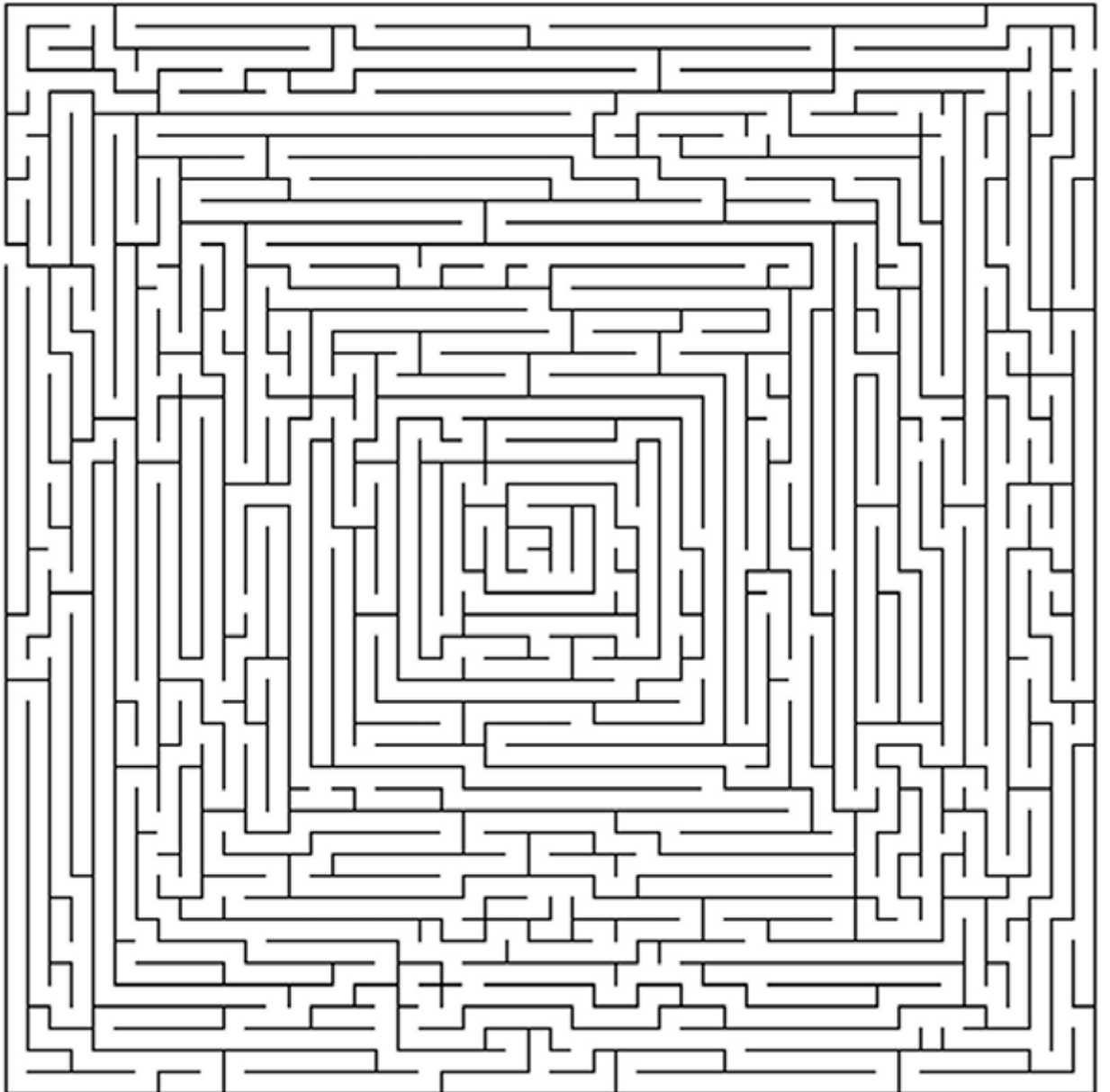

SECOND:

Gentry is 23, Eric is 35, Mark is 54, and Dan is 42.

The 42-year-old cannot be Gentry, Eric, or Mark, so it must be Dan.

The ones digit of Gentry's age isn't 5, nor is it 4 (Mark) or 2 (Dan), so it must be 3. Therefore, Gentry is 23.

The ones digit of Eric's age isn't 3 (Gentry), 4 (Mark), or 2 (Dan), so it must be 5. Therefore, Eric is 35.

The tens digit of Mark's age isn't 2 (Gentry), 3 (Eric), or 4 (Dan), so it must be 5. Therefore, Mark is 54.
